Students will be considered for this 07F revised BUS major if graduating 09S or later and not exceeding 100 qu upon completion of breadth and prerequisites, including ECON 102A and ECON 103A

It is not likely that seats will be available the first week of instruction.

BSAD is a selecting major! The selection criteria include:

- 2.5 minimum cumulative gpa and good academic standing
- 120 unit maximum after completing breadth & prerequisites or
100 unit maximum after completing breadth & prerequisites (07F version)
- 2.0 minimum gpa in separate categories of:
 - General Prerequisites for Business Major
 - Lower Division Major Prerequisites
 - Upper Division Major requirements completed (if any)

MATH - Most common reason for unsuccessful major changes from BSPR to BSAD is lack of progress each quarter in meeting MATH requirement!

If you have not taken the placement exam OR transferred in with C - or more in a Pre-Calculus or more advanced course YOU MUST sign up at the Learning Center, 1st floor, Surge Facility, www.learningcenter.ucr.edu (827-3722) to take a **Math Placement Exam** during your first quarter in either BSPR/BSAD.

Graduation Quarter - Most common reason for unsuccessful graduation is not starting Foreign Language in Junior year!

BSAD conforms to the College of Humanities, Arts & Social Sciences (CHASS) deadlines on their website and published in the Registrar's Schedule of Classes. This includes applications/petitions to graduate, walk, readmit and post transferable units or Foreign Language placement needed to graduate. Students who do not submit a Graduation Application on-line with CHASS by the published deadlines or who WITHDRAW from their graduation quarter after quarter begins will become future graduates even if requirements are completed.

(during grad qtr registration period; deadline is before fees due)

Only 2 enrolled Summer courses allowed to petition to participate in Commencement.

BSPR students who do not successfully major change to BSAD using 07W will not be able to participate in June Commencement (www.commencement.ucr.edu).

Senior Residency - 35 of your last 45 qtr units must be earned in residence at UCR. To comply with Sr Residency requirements and the 180 qtr unit minimum for graduation, transfer general elective classes or foreign language units no later than your Junior Year.

"F" grade - You ARE NOT eligible to remain in a class if you earned an "F" in its prerequisite ("C -" is required to advance to next MATH course). If you have not changed your enrollment or grade by the day after fees are due, **you will be dropped**.

READMITS must meet the same requirements as major change petitioners: 2.5 cum gpa; 60 qu; "C" in BSAD 20A or BUS 20, (Accounting); "C" in MATH 4 or 5, Pre-calculus or higher. Student must supply transcripts to Admissions and alpha advisor with petition.
