2007 – 2008 SCHOLARSHIP SUMMARY**

The awards listed are the AGSM scholarships available to students graduating Fall 2008 or later. In cases where the award is open to both undergraduate and graduate students or multiple awards are designated, the scholarship committee will determine how the awards are distributed. Scholarship applications are available at the front desk of the AGSM Undergraduate Programs Office in Anderson Hall.

All scholarship applications are due by Friday, May 2, 2008, at 5:00 p.m. Applications should be submitted to Thizel Aguilar or Lisa Miller in the AGSM Student Affairs Office. Scholarship winners will be notified and an Honors Recognition Ceremony will be held on June 6, 2008.

UNDERGRADUATE:

1. Bank of America Business Leaders Scholarship – For undergraduate business students demonstrating exceptional scholarship and promise. Two \$2,000 awards for undergraduates.
2. Gordon A. Blunden/Provident Savings Bank Business Scholarship – For undergraduate business students and MBA students. Academic performance and merit considered. Requires a 10-page report on either the Liquidity Crisis, Wall Street Bail-out, or Stated Income Lending, and, if invited, make a presentation to Provident's Board. \$3,000 award for both an undergraduate and graduate student.
3. Walter A. Henry Memorial Scholarship – Open to undergraduate business students and MBA students. Academic performance and merit considered. One \$1,000 award for either undergraduate or graduate student.
4. Suzanne Smith Carne Memorial Scholarship – For female lower division pre-business students. Academic performance and financial need considered. A maximum of four \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to undergraduates.
5. Michael Dailey Memorial Award- For an undergraduate student with an interest in real estate and superior performance in BUS 139- Real Estate Investments. One award for \$2,375 for an undergraduate student.
